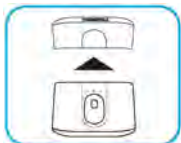


DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Please refer to the instruction booklet that came with your repeller for specific features and directions.

To Insert a Refill

Replace empty repellent refill when repeller is turned off. Open the repeller. Remove the cap from the refill. Drop the refill into base. Close the repeller.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION Harmful if swallowed. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply to water.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Use only with provided battery. Do not pry battery with any instrument or tool or put in a fire. Battery may burst or release toxic materials.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal of repellent unit.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed. Store. Do not disassemble appliance.

Should a battery become ruptured, do not allow contact with water. Keep refills out of direct sunlight.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL AND CONTAINER HANDLING:

Non-refillable cartridge. Do not reuse or refill this cartridge. **If empty or at the end of the season, dispose of unused**

portion according to label directions: Place in trash. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instruction. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
